



## Tips for a Great Class

1. Invite friends from work, friends from church and neighbors. Have each guest bring along one of their friends. A class fills up quickly that way!
2. Invite a few extra friends to cover for some of those last minute cancellations. Example-if you want to have 5 guests, invite 7-8.
3. Let your guests know that they will receive 1 hour of pamper time and **ARE NOT** obligated to buy anything.
4. Have a guest list ready with name, address, and phone number 3-5 days before your class so I can call and preprofile each guest.
5. Remember that being a hostess is something special and you will be redeeming you \$100 gift certificate. We can decide together what you want to use you certificate on or you can have that picked out ahead of time.
6. Don't forget to get outside orders from friends and family who are unable to attend to ensure the \$300 in sales to redeem your gift certificate.
7. Collect the money for outside orders when you write the sales ticket (provided in the hostess packet). This will save time in the long run because you won't have to go back and collect later.
